You are welcome to take part in the 3rd International Art Medals Biennial organized by Zespół Państwowych Szkół Plastycznych in Warsaw, in cooperation with the Mint of Poland, the Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw, and art schools in Poland and abroad.

This edition is dedicated to science and technique. The theme of the first stage of the competition is **"Great Inventors and Discoverers in Science and Technology"**. The students will be required to make drawings and medals made of plaster. This stage will be held in the participating students' schools. After sending the medals and boards with the concept sketches to ZPSP in Warsaw, the works are going to be evaluated by the elected jury. Laureates of the first stage will be qualified to the second stage depending on scores awarded. The second stage of the biennial will be art medals workshops dealing with science and technology. These will be held for the laureates of the first stage. The workshops will consist of plein-air classes, art medals workshops and lectures. The workshops will be an occasion for the youth to meet, co-operate and work with sculpture teachers. The authors of the best works will receive prizes. All of the works will be displayed at an exhibition organized by ZPSP. Any information concerning the competition and the workshops will be posted on the website of the school.

REGULATIONS

1. The organiser of the competition is W. Gersona's Zespół Państwowych Szkół Plastycznych in Warsaw, will henceforth be named The Organiser.
2. The objective of the competition is to design a medal titled: **"Great Inventors and Discoverers in Science and Technology"**
3. The competition is for students aged 15-20. Taking part is free and voluntary.

The aim of the competition is designing a medal titled "Great Inventors and Discoverers in Science and Technology" as well as making a board with the inspirations for the project of the medal.

- **The medal needs to be made with ceramic plaster (uncoloured) or any other white plaster with similar parameters. Both the obverse and reverse are to be done separately. The shape of the medal is free to choose. The maximum size allowed cannot exceed 21 cm. It's not allowed to attach the medal to a full-scale drawing.**
 - **The project needs to include: name of the inventor or discoverer, dates associated with the life and work of the inventor/discoverer and a composition of the invention or the way leading to the invention. It's also possible to include the image of the inventor/discoverer himself.**
 - **The board with inspirations has to be 50 cm x 70 cm, and the works have to be glued to a stiff board. The projects (in all their forms) should be sent (safely packed) to the Organiser before 4 PM, April 9th-April 18th 2018, at the address ZPSP, Warszawa 01-009, ul. Smocza 6, signed – "Great Inventors and Discoverers in Science and Technology"**
 - **The sent board has to be genuine and not previously presented. It needs to be signed at the back (boards and the medal). The application form needs to be attached to the project. It is available on the Organiser's website: zpsp.smocza.edu.pl**
4. **Signing and sending the project/work together with the application form means accepting all of the rules of this regulation and agreeing to processing personal data as the need of above competition arises (according to of August 29th 1997 regarding protecting personal data (Dz.U. z 2002 r. nr 101, poz. 926 ze zm.). Furthermore, this also means transferring copyright to the Organiser.**
 5. The Organiser will choose a jury for the competition consisting of sculptors, medallists, teachers from the Academy of Fine Arts and ZPSP in Warsaw.
 6. The results of the first stage will be published on the 27th of April 2018 on the Organiser's website zpsp.smocza.edu.pl

7. The authors of the projects chosen by the jury during the first stage of the biennial will be allowed to participate in sculpture workshops in ZPSP in Warsaw in September 2018.
8. The works will be judged in accordance with:
 - following the topic
 - originality, ingenuity and innovation of the project
 - aesthetics of the project
9. The laureates of the first stage of the competition will receive diplomas and prizes, which will be sent to them in the post by May 2018.
10. Competition's stages:
 - 1st stage – designing the medal (obverse and reverse) together with the board with inspirations, due by April 18th 2018
 - 2nd stage – laureates taking part in sculpture workshops, plein-air classes and lectures on ZPSP premises.
 - 3rd stage – judging the works made during the workshops, choosing the Grand Prix and distinguished works. The Grand Prix, 1st Prize, 2nd Prize and 3rd Prize will be presented.
 - 4th stage – organising an exhibition of the works and photos taken during the workshops – October 2018
11. The jury of the 2nd stage of the competition will present non-cash awards.
12. Organiser holds the right to change the regulations. Anything that was not mentioned in the regulations is to be evaluated by the Organiser.
